

Sequence of Steps



- **Council approval of extension of Russian share in experiments**
 - Background: The share in experiments from Russian FAIR funds was limited to 17.7 M EUR
 - Extending this would mean that money could be missing elsewhere
- **Council decision on funding of the Solenoid by ROSATOM**
 - The collaboration requests funding of the Solenoid
 - Dubna expresses the interest to commit to this
- **Decision of FAIR Council on July 9th:**
 - *Approval of Russian contributions*
 - *But only within the 17.7 M EUR*
 - *Further discussion on Sep 23*

 - Appendix 2: Payment schedule and related milestones
 - Appendix 3: Technical specifications → *PANDA magnet group*
- Template exists*
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Contract Work Status



- Main contract and appendices: template exists
- Work on specification document well advanced
- To be done: milestones and payment schedule
This has to be adapted to the project requirements
- Translation to Russian to be done by FAIR
- Main responsibility and project management are with JINR

Open Questions



- Political situation on the experiment shares
- Partners of final contract PANDA – CERN:
 - Dubna – CERN: logical
 - FAIR – CERN: possible
- Prefinancing, Council approval provided
 - Dubna (or FAIR) prefinances PANDA – CERN contract
 - CERN prefinances PANDA – CERN contract
- Who contracts conductor, coil winding and supplies?
 - Dubna orders material and does sub-contracting *simplest*
 - FAIR orders material and does sub-contracting *possible*
 - CERN orders material and does sub-contracting *unlikely*
