## CONFERENCE VENUE AND TRAVEL INFO

The meeting will be held in the Courtyard Marriott Hotel in the city center of Berlin, address: Axel-Springer-Strasse 55, 10117.

Berlin can be easily reached by plane both from within Germany and from main cities outside Germany. Trains to Berlin from main German cities run almost every hour, the German Railway website offers a variety of connections and online tickets. From Berlin airports or Berlin main train station you can conveniently use the public transport network to reach the hotel.

We recommend to make travel arrangements to Berlin such that you arrive at the hotel on Sunday afternoon, September 15th and depart from the hotel on Saturday afternoon, September 21st.

## REGISTRATION

Online registration is available through the conference webpage. Registration without abstract submission is not possible. By the end of June the registrants will be informed via email whether their contributions have been selected for oral presentation. Payment of the conference fee is required upon receiving the invitation by email.

The conference fee is 350 Euro/participant for accommodation in a shared double-room, and 710 Euro/participant for accommodation in a single-room.

The conference fee covers:

- lunch at the conference site and coffee-breaks
- proceedings costs

Included in the conference fee are also the welcome drink on Sunday, September 15th and the conference dinner on Wednesday, September 18th.
