- Erasmus+ programs to support mobility of young talented students who we need for future operations of FAIR.





Eligibility

- Bachelor/Master or Ph.D. student from any eligible universities from Programme countries
- (depending on the case recent graduates in between degrees are also eligible)
- All STEM including management and technology transfer topics are included.

Funding

- Monthly lump sum by Erasmus+ (via University)
- in-kind support ca. 630€by hosting department (GSI)
- We encourage to apply for Green Travel grant covering the Travel expenses
- Health Insurance covered through home country EHIC

No deadlines (at FAIR/GSI)


Duration

ERASMUS+ - In 2023 we have recruited more than 35 Trainees.






Lessons learnt from Coordinating for 5 years now!





The Matchmaking provided by our team have been constantly praised, and utilized. Approx. 75% of the incoming Erasmus+ trainees are through Matchmaking.



The programme allowed to change the mindset in campus to look at ERASMUS+ traineeships as a medium to help provide mobility to their collaborators at the doctoral level.



Deadlines are on the University end more stricter than at FAIR/GSI. We have been able to secure placement and confirmation as low as 3 working days.
