## Programme and Schedule – preliminary

The programme will start on Monday, 29 September 2025 and end on Thursday, 2 October 2025 around noon. The first day is reserved for sub-collaboration meetings and work-group meetings. The final two and a half days are reserved for plenary sessions. Further details will be provided later.

### **Venue and Location**

The <u>NUSTAR Week 2025</u> will take place in the premises of the Czech Association of Scientific and Technical Societies, Novotneho lavka 200/5, Prague, Czechia (<u>location on Google maps</u>), where both the plenary sessions and the professional meetings will be held. The venue is located in the historic centre of Prague in the vicinity of the famous Charles Bridge.

#### **Travel information**

In order to reach the city centre from the Vaclav Havel Airport Prague, one can take an Uber Airport, a trolleybus, or a bus. To reach the area of the conference venue, the Trolleybus line 59 followed by a Metro line A (green) and a short walk is the easiest (route on Google maps). More detailed information on the public transportation will be provided in the Second Circular.

As the city centre is easily accessible by the public transportation, the Local Organizing Committee does not recommend coming to the conference venue by car as parking in the city centre is extremely difficult. If you arrive to Prague by car, please check that your hotel offers parking.
