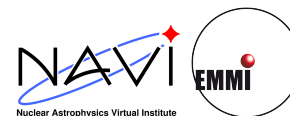

DIRECT REACTIONS WITH EXOTIC BEAMS
DREB2014

Darmstadt, Germany, June 30 – July 4, 2014

The 8th International Workshop on “Direct Reactions with Exotic Beams – DREB2014” will be held in Darmstadt, Germany from June 30th to July 4th.

This meeting, which is being jointly organized by Technical University Darmstadt and GSI, will be the latest in the series which began in 1999 at the initiative of physicists working in the field from NSCL-MSU, IPN-Orsay and FSU. Previous meetings were hosted by NSCL-MSU (1999 & 2005), IPN-Orsay (2001), University of Surrey (2003), RIKEN (2007), FSU (2009), and Pisa (2012). The workshop focuses on the experimental, theoretical and instrumental aspects of direct reactions with radioactive beams.

The meeting will run from Monday 30th June after lunch through lunch Friday 4th July in the conference center darmstadtium in down-town Darmstadt. It is currently envisaged that the programme will include, in addition to the scientific sessions, a short excursion and a workshop dinner.

In keeping with the workshop’s tradition, the meeting will be of a relatively informal character: no proceedings will be published. All the presentations, other than the keynote Opening talks, will be selected by the Advisory Committee on the basis of contributed abstracts only. Importantly a strong emphasis will be placed on those presenting new results – in particular those which have not yet been published. In addition there will be a poster session.

In keeping with the tradition of the DREB workshops, the costs to the participants will be kept to a minimum. A registration fee of €100 is envisaged, and around €50 will be requested for guest accompanying participants to the workshop dinner. PhD candidates and students are encouraged to participate in the workshop and can be supported with €100 via the workshop supporters HIC for FAIR, NAVI, and EMMI if requested through an informal application.

Darmstadt is very convenient accessible via Frankfurt airport, which is well connected with Darmstadt via bus or 20 min taxi drive.
