

WHAT?

During a science slam presenters have ten minutes to explain their research topic in an entertaining way. The presentation must be understandable to a non-scientific audience and avoid scientfic jargon. A jury composed of scientists and non-scientists, together with the audience vote to determine the winner.

WHO?

Entries are invited from all research centers belonging to the Helmholtz Association.

WHEN & WHERE?

The semi-finals will take place at the DKFZ in Heidelberg on 24th July and the best two teams will fight it out in the final on the evening of 25th July, during the DKFZ summer party

HOW?

- Up to 4 people per team (half must be PhD students)
- 10 minutes in English
- Limited props and effects are allowed (subject to a technical feasibility check!)
