Measures that SIST are pursuing:

Disposal of unnecessary equipment

Defining the priorities of the examinations Contacts in the departments must be named, executives and STVs are urgently asked to do so An additional employee is working together with M. Hirsch (C. Schecker since 06/ 19, so he will be fully productive soon) Support costs and effort per external company will be reduced -> More testing services by external companies per time Hazard assessments for test period extension of a few work tools Superordinate table with categories of testable work equipment in terms of organization and rules has been created by M. Hirsch and C. Schecker).

Development of a concept to improve test procedures

Mr Blaurock suggested implementing all the above measures quickly and carefully and saw no reason to cancel the beam time or similar things.
